DUES

Dues for AWANA Clubs pay for the awards which will be received as each section is passed in the AWANA Handbooks and for book awards at the end of the year.

1 st Child	\$15.00
2 nd Child	\$10.00
3 rd Child	\$ 5.00
4 th Child+	Free

Your child will earn \$15 in AWANA bucks to spend at the AWANA Store if their dues and books are paid on or before September 28th.

One check can be written for a family. Please make check payable to Connection Church and give it to the club secretary at the check-in table for recording.

HANDBOOKS

The AWANA Handbooks have the sections which your child will work on and learn to earn his or her awards. We have handbooks available for all clubs which you can buy as they pass their entrance requirements or complete each book.

Handbooks for all ages are \$12.00

UNIFORMS

The AWANA uniform identifies which club your children belong to, provides a place to display the awards they earn, and shows others that they are a member of the AWANA Clubs. You will want to order a uniform for your children as soon as they complete the entrance requirements for their club.

Once they receive their uniforms, they should wear it to all club meetings. Uniforms should be clean and awards displayed proudly. Awards will be held in the AWANA office until a uniform has been purchased for proper award display. Extra points will be awarded if clubbers wear their uniforms to school. The cost of the uniforms are as follows:

T&T Jersey	\$17.00
Sparks uniform vest	\$12.00
Cubbies uniform vest	\$12.00

Qualified children (those who have finished their entrance booklets) will receive their books and uniforms upon payment. A payment plan can be set up if necessary. Please see club secretary or director or email the secretary.

<u>AWANA Handbooks – What you should know:</u>

The Handbook is a vital tool for your child's success in AWANA. It helps them to learn about the Lord and reinforces his positive moral standards. Please be sure your children have their handbooks weekly.

Clubber's Role

Here are a few things to remember:

- Clubbers must have their Handbooks at club to receive credit for sections passed that evening.
- No more than 2 helps per section are given in order to receive credit.
- Sections are passed when said to an AWANA leader or listener.
- In order to finish their handbooks by year-end, clubbers must pass 2 or 3 sections every week.
- Clubbers may be restricted to the number of sections passed because of the number of children present at club and/or number of helpers available. If the clubber is prepared with more sections, the leaders would be happy to assist them after club night is over to pass off extra sections.

Parent's Role

How you can help:

- Help your children be disciplined by having them study 10-15 minutes per day in their handbooks.
- Do your best to explain the meaning of each verse. You will find that your children memorize more quickly when they understand what they are memorizing.
- Please initial next to the verses the sections you feel they are ready to recite.
- Bring your children every week and encourage them in their work.

- Write the words of verses on 3"x5" cards. Shuffle the cards and ask your children to arrange them in order.
- Write verses on poster boards or white boards and hang them around the house.

AWANA Club Nightly Schedule

AWANA Clubs meet from 6:00-7:45 p.m. (except Trek/LITT-please see below) on Wednesday evenings. Our flag ceremony begins promptly at 6:00 p.m. for all clubbers. *The doors will be closed at 6:00 pm until the flag ceremony is over, so please plan to arrive no later than 5:50 p.m.* so that you can bring your children inside to sign in and be ready for the flag ceremony. This sets the tone for the evening so please make every effort to be on time.

CLUB GUIDELINES

PLEASE REVIEW WITH YOUR CHILDREN

Be Prepared

- Come prepared to participate and to have fun.
- Wear modest, comfortable clothing. Tennis shoes are required, as Game Time is active.
- Bring your AWANA Handbook and Bible.
- Come ready to recite verses and work on them.
- Wear your uniform.

Be Considerate

- Be kind treat others the way you want to be treated.
- Be on time be ready for Flag Ceremony by 6:00 arrive at 5:50 unless eating a meal.
- Work quietly during Handbook Time while others are reciting.
- Encourage one another in Game Time.
- Listen guietly in Council Time and Green Meadow Time
- Treat the church building with respect It's the Lord's House.
- Respect the personal space of others; keep your hands to yourself.

Be Safe

- Walk in the building except during Game Time, of course.
- Remain inside the church building until your parents come inside to pick you up. Parents, please come inside the building to pick your children up and to check them in.
- Do not come to Club if you are sick, have a fever, or are coughing/sneezing due to sickness.

Be Obedient

- Know and listen for the "Five Count" which means to be quiet before the count of "Five".
- Listen and follow instructions given by your Leaders, Directors and the Commander.

THE THREE STRIKE RULE

A clubber who will not follow these guidelines will be given a "one strike" by the leader in charge. A "two strike" is given for a second offense and if there is still a problem, the clubber will be put on a "three strike". The clubber will then be taken to the AWANA Commander, who will contact the parents to come and take their child home. The child is not allowed to come to Club the following week, but is welcomed back thereafter, with the understanding the child will follow the Club Guidelines.

For Your Information

If you are sick and can't come to Club . . .

Bring a note from home the following week and you will get credit for your attendance award. If you can't come and normally ride with someone, please let them know.

If you lose a book or award . . .

You may buy another book for \$12. Awards normally cost from 25¢ to \$1.00.

If you bring a friend . . .

Please arrive by 5:50 so that we can meet your friend, register their attendance, and you can show your friend around.

If you need help with Club costs . . .

Please let your leader know. We have a scholarship and an Adopt-A-Clubber program. We do not want finances to prevent your children from attending AWANA.
